



## U.P. Championship Rodeo Ticket Policies

**By purchasing, accepting, or using a U.P. Championship Rodeo ticket, any original ticket holder or subsequent ticket holder(s) agree to the U.P. Championship Rodeo Ticket Policies included herein. If you do not agree with the ticket policies, please do not purchase tickets.**

### General

- U.P. Championship Rodeo is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged tickets or property.
- For the safety and security of patrons, ticket holder and ticket holder's belongings may be searched upon entrance to the U.P. Championship Rodeo, and ticket holder hereby consents to such search and waives all related claims.
- U.P. Championship Rodeo does not allow certain items at the event. The following items are NOT allowed:
  - Outside foods or drinks
  - Coolers
  - Weapons
  - Smoking or vaping in bleachers
- We know that some of you love your pets like family, however, for the safety of all patrons, pets of any kind are prohibited at the rodeo. Exceptions to this policy will be made for service animals as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- If the ticket holder's conduct endangers or disrupts patrons or others involved in the event, management reserves the right to remove the ticket holder from the premises.
- Ticket holder voluntarily assumes all risks and danger of personal injury and all other hazards arising from or related

in any way to the event for which the ticket is for

- Rodeo grounds are Handicap and wheelchair accessible for guests. Walkway is paved from the entrance gate to grandstands, that is accessible by a ramp. Highly advise arriving early to secure the best seats.
- Parking is \$5 per vehicle on the rodeo grounds and your pass can be used the entire weekend.
- For your safety please do not stand or lean on the arena gate panels.

### Tickets

- All persons six years old and over must present a ticket to enter the event.
- A ticket is good for one rodeo performance only.
- This ticket is a revocable license and admission may be refused.
- No reserved seating - only general admission seating. First come first seating is the policy so the earlier you arrive, the better choice of seats. Gates open 2 hours before each rodeo performance.
- Tickets will be included in confirmation email if purchased before the rodeo. Can either print tickets from email or save tickets to your phone. Tickets will not be mailed. Be prepared to have your tickets scanned at the gate.

- You are able to edit your tickets in your confirmation email up to July 10<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 p.m. A \$3.00 fee will apply.

### **Photography and Filming**

- Ticket holder's name, voice, image and likeness may be used by U.P. Championship Rodeo in any written/audio account, picture, or video taken in connection with the event for any purpose, including U.P. Championship Rodeo promotional purposes, with no further compensation to or consent from the ticket holder.
- Cameras, including cell phones and small handheld devices, are permitted on the premises for personal use only. The commercial use of photos or video recordings of the event is strictly prohibited.
- Cameras with a professional lens (over three inches) or flash attachments, monopods, tripods, and selfie sticks are prohibited.
- Special permission for professional video/photography, including news or media, may be approved. Requests must be made 2 weeks prior to the event through the U.P. Championship Rodeo email [info@uprodeo.com](mailto:info@uprodeo.com).
- If guests are found with cameras/equipment without prior approval, you will be asked to exit and take your equipment to your vehicle. You will have the option to remain and enjoy the rodeo. Tickets will not be refunded after purchase because of guests not acknowledging or inquiring about our policies before their visit.
- Cameras and cases may be subject to search upon entering the premises.

- All ticketholders must abide by [PRCA Media Guidelines](#) and [Social Media Policies](#). Photographs & Video taken at U.P. Championship Rodeo cannot be sold without the permission from the PRCA.

### **Refunds**

- U.P. Championship Rodeo takes place rain or shine. No refunds will be issued for inclement weather.
- All ticket sales are deemed as final, and we do not offer refunds. This policy applies to all ticket purchases made through our website or any authorized ticketing platform (Rodeo Ticket).
- Disputing charges processed by or on behalf of the Upper Peninsula Championship Rodeo including by its partner, Rodeo Ticket, may result in being blacklisted (banned) from future purchases and should not be used as a method for obtaining a “refund”.

### **Service Fees**

- All U.P. Championship Rodeo ticket purchases through Rodeo Ticket will incur fees based on the face value of the ticket.

### **Ticket Reselling**

- U.P. Championship Rodeo’s official ticket provider is Rodeo Ticket. U.P. Championship Rodeo is in no way affiliated with any other ticket provider and cannot guarantee ticket authenticity from other providers.
- You assume all risk when purchasing tickets through a scalper, third-party reseller, or nonauthorized ticket center, and U.P. Championship Rodeo will not

be able to guarantee validation for purchases through any avenue other than Rodeo Ticket.

- Do not make additional copies of your ticket as tickets will be scanned at the gate and duplicates will be rejected.
- U.P. Championship Rodeo forbids the resale or attempted resale of tickets at a price higher than the face value printed on the ticket. Violations may result in a ticket seizure and/or cancellation.
